The afternoon saw the start of our swimming lessons for the children, kindly donated by our friends at Excite Broxburn. The children enjoyed a period of play in the pool before the serious lessons began.

Chris took the lessons. There was lots of splashing, walking in the water, swimming with armbands and floats etc until they got more confident. Some were very apprehensive to begin with, but good progress was made. It's a very important part of our programme. Its so warm in Belarus in the summer that children do play in open water and we have had siblings of children in our groups who have drowned as a result.

The children came back to the hall after swimming to make some thank you cards for us to hand out to our activity providers during the visit. Some lovely designs.
