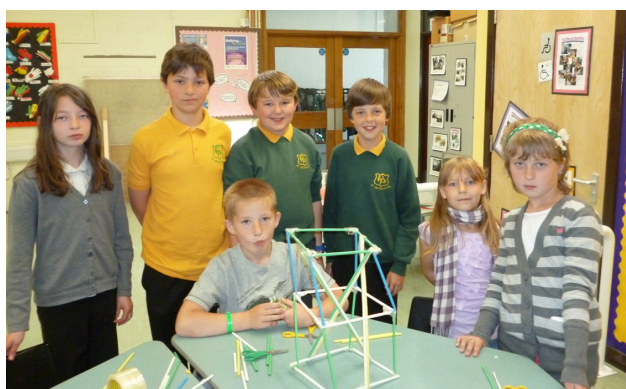




Daily Blog for the group visit ~ 2nd June to 30th June 2012
