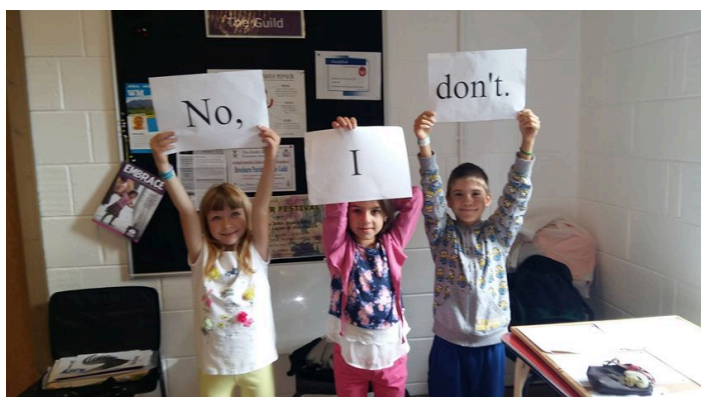




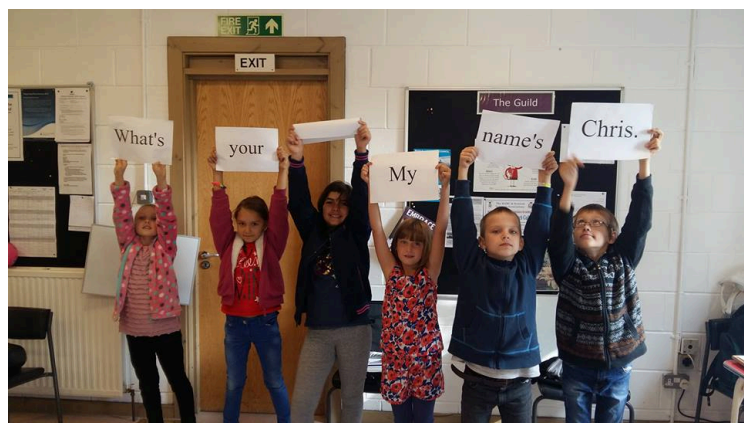


## Tuesday 6 September – School/Swimming
